<p>Social</p>	<p>Infants: <u>What Can I See?</u>; peek-a-boo; face-to-face with other infants or adult; soft doll play; blow bubbles Toddlers: <u>Spring is Here!</u>; tents and tunnel play; musical instruments parade; doll play; activity tower Preschoolers: <u>The Hungry Farmer</u>; doll house play; career costumes; kitchen work; doing laundry; board games School Age Children: <u>Duck On a Bike</u>; board and card games; Pet Clinic; doll house play; finger puppets</p>
